We assess our bursary places on an individual basis. The list below cover situations which automatically qualify a young person for a free bursary place, however if your child does not automatically qualify but you feel your situation warrants a bursary place, please do discuss this with a member of the team.

LAC- foster placement/ group home

Living with legal Carer/ Guardian

Parent in prison

Resettled or temporarily housed by police or local authority /social services

Supported under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

English as a 2nd language

Finance (of the household)

Disability Living Allowance (DLA - paid to anyone in the household)

Household income of under £16,190

Job Seekers / Employment Support Allowance (paid to anyone in the household)

Working Tax Credits (paid to anyone in the household)

Child Tax Credits (paid to anyone in the household)

Universal Credits (paid to anyone in the household)

Health (of the young person, not resulting in DLA)

Dyslexia

EHC plan

ASD

Dyspraxia

ADD

OCD

Anxiety / depression

ADHD
